GROUP C: Boys Green & under heavyweights:	Total Weight	160 Kg	Individual minimum 40 kg, max 65 kg.
GROUP D: Girls Yellow & under lightweights:	Total Weight	100 Kg	Individual maximum 40 Kg.
GROUP E: Girls Green & under heavyweights:	Total Weight	150 Kg	Individual minimum 35 kg, max 60 kg.

Players may compete in several groups if they qualify but cannot compete for more than 1 team in the same group. Players up to 5 kg below the minimum weight will be allowed to compete but will be deemed to be the minimum weight. BJA technical restrictions (the old U12 rules) will apply in groups A and D, irrespective of age. Players do not have to be from the same club and the Samurai "swap shop" board will be in use for any club with spare players or a player short. If there are 2 players their combined weight must be no more than 75% of the total weight and the weight "missing" will decide which position in the team is vacant.

Clubs with a history of sending extremely under graded players to events will have their entries returned.

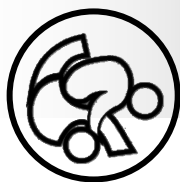

### Notes

Both competitors in junior categories must be under the specified age on the day. In Junior Nage, if one player is under 12 and one over 12, they must enter the under 16 category. No age limit in other categories. A player cannot enter the same category twice, either with a different partner or reversing roles.

All competitors must hold BJA membership or equivalent and must wear white judogi with red or white belt. Standard for judging is the Kodokan video tapes except Gonosen No Kata which is BJA Kata Commission version with slow motion.

Entry fee: £6 per person per kata up to 2 katas, £3 per person for any subsequent katas.

Entry fees paid on the day, without exception, will be subject to £2 surcharge per person per kata, but please let us know you are coming to help us prepare paperwork.

Junior Katame & Ju No Katas are judged on the first two sets only. Again players are welcome to present the full kata.

## Minimon Day

Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2012

Glades Leisure Centre, Bromsgrove Street, Kidderminster DY10 1PP

This is a new concept, run for the first time. The day will be in three stages, each involving all of the players. All players must be yellow belt or below, and (except novices) should have graded within the last 9 months.

### Stage 1: Individual Categories

All players will be sorted into categories of 4 or 5 where possible. This will be done by the index method of adding each player's weight, grade and age and then splitting into groups. Every competitor will receive a medal.

### Stage 2: Team Categories

Boys Teams: U27, U30, U35, U40, U50 (one player each weight)

Girls Teams: U28, U34, U40 (one player each weight)

Clubs can arrange their players into teams as desired (can be done on the day). Where a team is a player short, players may be borrowed from other clubs. Scratch teams will also be made up of spare players. The intention is to get as many of the players into teams as possible. The team event will be pools into KO and repechage or compound repechage. Only the top four teams in each category will receive a medal. (These will be different medals to Stage 1).

### Stage 3: Open Randori

After stage 2, there will be an open randori session for all players lasting approximately one hour depending on time. Generally half of the players will be on for each practice whilst the others rest and arrange next partners, depending on numbers. Club coaches are invited to come onto the mat to help, encourage and supervise.

**Notes:** This is an event for inexperienced players, not gong-hunters. Entries from known gong-hunting clubs or clubs with a history of substantially undergraded players will be returned. There will be a large number of junior referees on duty. This event should be seen as an introduction to competitive judo for newer players. Positive coaching is allowed but aggressive coaching and attempted pressuring of referees will not be allowed.

All competitors must be under 16 years old on the day (minimum age 8) & hold current BJA membership or equivalent. Those with non-BJA grades should not hold grades above yellow. Players must wear white judogi. Two star tournament licence. BJA Technical Restrictions (the old U12 rules) will apply in all categories, irrespective of age.

Weigh-In: Boys: 9:00 am to 9:30 am Girls: 10:00 am to 10:30 am

Expected finish time: approx. 4.00 pm or earlier. All medals will be presented at the end of the day.

A kyu grade team event will be running at the same time (from around noon onwards).

Players must be at least 14 years of age on the day and hold in date BJA licence or equivalent, senior or student/youth.

Method of competition will be pools, K.O. and repechage. BJA Three Star point scoring event.

There will be a "Swap Shop" board for any teams lacking a player or players looking to enter a team on the day.

A junior minimon event will be running simultaneously.

### Notes

Each team should start with three players. If there are 2 players their combined weight must be no more than 75% of the total weight and the weight "missing" will decide which position in the team is vacant. Players below the minimum weight shall be deemed the minimum weight. Teams fight in weight order, lightest first. Players can fight in more than one category (e.g. Boys LW and Boys HW) if they meet the criteria but they may not fight in two teams in the same category. Juniors must be under 16 years of age (minimum age 8) on the day and seniors must be at least 14 years of age on the day and hold youth or senior membership. All players must possess a valid, in date BJA licence or equivalent and must wear white judogi. Method of competition will be pools, K.O. and repechage.

BJA Four Star point scoring event.

There will be a "Swap Shop" board for any teams lacking a player or players looking to enter a team on the day.

BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to all Junior Lightweight teams, irrespective of age or grade.

It will be suitable for players or coaches who have not previously done kata.

It would be highly advisable, although not essential, to come in pairs. Players coming solo may be able to pair up if there are other individuals available.

## Dan Grade Theory Course & Exam

Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2012

Venue: Samurai Judo Club, Zortech Avenue, Kidderminster DY11 7DY

The course, run by Ben Newbury, will cover all of the requirements for contest dan grade theory up to 4<sup>th</sup> dan going for 5<sup>th</sup> dan. Candidates are advised, however, that there is a lot to take in and they should make some attempt to learn what they can before the course. In one day, a course can only act as a refresher and a clarification of areas of confusion and the less well known techniques, as well as explaining what examiners look for. A partner is useful but not essential.

Once the single techniques and one set of each type of combinations have been covered, 1<sup>st</sup> kyu players can take the examination. The examiner will be Andrew Haffner, Senior Examiner 195. Meanwhile 1<sup>st</sup> dan players will go through another set of combinations, after which they can take their exam, and so on. The course will include a set of nage no kata for 3<sup>rd</sup> dan (we usually teach the 3<sup>rd</sup> set, the ashiwazas) and a set of katame no kata for 4<sup>th</sup> dan (the 2<sup>nd</sup> set, shimewazas).

There is no guarantee that candidates will pass the exam, but our courses do have a very good history of preparing candidates well, as well as being related to contest and technical judo and hopefully being informative, interesting and friendly. As well as being competitive 3<sup>rd</sup> dan with outstanding knowledge of the syllabus, Ben is a National B Referee and former British Kata Champion and has run many similar successful courses in the past.

Candidates seeking technical dan grade exams can be examined on the day, but the course will not cover the specific requirements.

**Eligibility:** players must currently hold the grade below the grade they are going for (e.g. must be 1<sup>st</sup> kyu if attempting 1<sup>st</sup> dan theory) and must hold current BJA membership which must be produced on the day.
